Can I Become A Scuba Diver?

Yes, if you are 10 years or older, if you are in good health
if you can swim 200 yards and tread water for 10 minutes

How Do I Become A Certified Diver?

Take the PADI Open Water Scuba Diver Course (PADI – Professional Association of Diving Instructors)

The PADI Open Water Diver Course is divided into three parts

- 1. Academics:** You learn about equipment, technique, and proper procedures for safe diving.
- 2. Pool:** Using scuba equipment you practice the techniques and skills discussed in the classroom. In the pool you will gain confidence in your ability to safely use the equipment.
- 3. Open Water Certification Dives:** You need to complete 4 open water training dives with a PADI instructor over two days

How Much Does It Cost? For Classroom and pool

Do the classroom portion online then the pool portion with Scuba Buddys: Cost is \$480Includes tuition, support material, pool fees and all the equipment needed to complete the pool sessions. Does not include Mask, Snorkel, Boots and Fins

What Equipment Do I Need?

You will need a mask, snorkel, boots, and fins.

For Open Water Certification dives you have two options

Option 1 Do your Open Water Certification Dives with Scuba Buddys: \$360 ... For all four open water training dives. Includes all scuba equipment (tanks, regulators, BCDs, wetsuits, and weights) needed for participating in the open water dives, logbook and card processing, two days entry fees to Lake Phoenix. You will need to dive with us on two days. Does not include Mask, Snorkel, Boots or Fins.

Option 2 Do your certification dives with a PADI facility other than Scuba Buddys: \$45... Includes student referral form and Logbook
